Pastor Note:

Some things are true of all of us. We are all breathing, have beating hearts, and blood is flowing through our veins. We all have a hue, take up space, and don't do well without water and food. We all have our quirks, laugh at some things and frown at others, and certainly, none of us is perfect (if you think you are, we just identified one of your imperfections). And we are influenced, shaped, and eternally impacted by prophets, priests, and kings.

Prophets. The voices we listen to, respect, and heed. Those who shape our values, our morals, our sense of right and wrong. They don't have to be religious to impact us in a religious way. Of course, true prophets are always religious because they are spokespersons of God, always speak the truth (even if we don't like it or refuse to hear it), and never have the luxury of making false predictions. Historically, false, self-proclaimed, and godless prophets are vastly more popular because they are good at telling people what they want to hear instead of what they need to hear.

Priests. Those who mediate between us and our gods, are our spiritual advisors, hear our confessions, and who have a remedy for and absolve us of our sins. They too are not necessarily religious, but every system of belief or unbelief has them. Of course, true priests, like true prophets, are first of all servants of the only true God. Serving anyone or anything else but God alone disqualifies anyone from being a true priest and mocks what a priest is supposed to be.

Kings. Who or what rules and leads us, who or what we are submitted to. Of course, kings, like prophets and priests, don't have to be religious to rule us. In fact, we are more prone to give kings a religious exemption, and for good reason, too often we have seen them use religion as a mere tool of power. Nevertheless, we benefit when those who rule us are themselves submitted to and ruled by God. This is also true of each one of us personally, there is nothing and no one better to rule our hearts, minds, and lives than God, than Jesus Christ.

"The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. You must listen to him" Deuteronomy 18:15 (HCSB), Acts 7:37.

"We have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, ..." Hebrews 4:14 (NLT2). "Jesus became a priest, not by meeting the physical requirement of belonging to the tribe of Levi, but by the power of a life that cannot be destroyed. And the psalmist pointed this out when he prophesied, "You are a priest forever in the order of Melchizedek" Hebrews 4:14, 7:16-17 (NLT2). "There is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus" 1 Timothy 2:5 (NASB).

"On his robe at his thigh was written this title: King of all kings and Lord of all lords" Revelation 19:16 (NLT2). "God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" Philippians 2:9-11 (NLT2).

Who are your prophet, priest, and king? Your answer will determine both your life here and now and your eternity. Only Jesus Christ is worthy to be Prophet, Priest, and King. Only Jesus Christ is the eternal and faithful Prophet, Priest, and King. Only Jesus Christ is the God-appointed Prophet, Priest, and King. Choosing, listening to, and serving any other prophet, priest, or king is both an affront to God and the most serious and far-reaching mistake anyone can make. So, who has your ear? Who mediates between you and God? And, who or what rules your life? Make sure it is Christ on all three counts.
